

1. Pierce the four recessed points on the underside of the lip above the opening of the kennel, using an auger, needle file, small screw or similar, to create holes for the retaining bolts.
2. Fold the four "ears" at the top of the plastic door to an angle of 90 degrees, and align new holes created above the kennel opening with the pre-cut holes in the "ears" below. Ensure the "ears" are on the inside of the door, pointing in towards the centre of the kennel.
3. One at a time, insert a retaining bolt down through the new hole in the kennel and then through the pre-cut hole in the "ear" of the plastic door below. Offer up one of the locking blocks to the end of the bolt, and screw into the centre of the block with a screwdriver. Repeat with the other three "ears" to secure the door to the kennel.
